At Pets Alive, saving lives doesn't stop at our local borders. Thanks to strong partnerships and our incredible supporters, we've been able to open our doors — and our hearts — to dogs in need from across the country.

Recently, we teamed up with All Kind Animal Initiative in Abilene, Texas and Paws for Life K9 Rescue in Los Angeles, California to transport atrisk dogs to safety here in New York. Many of these pups came from overcrowded shelters where their futures were uncertain.

Upon arrival, they were greeted with love, warm beds, tail wags, and the first step toward their forever homes. Some have already been adopted, while others are enjoying life with our staff and volunteers as they wait for their perfect match.

But our lifesaving journey doesn't stop there...

Next Stop: Jamaica

In partnership with our friends at Wings of **Rescue**, we are preparing for an upcoming

transport of 12 dogs from Negril, Jamaica. These pups were displaced by Hurricane Melissa, and while their arrival has been delayed due to storm efforts, recovery we standing by and ready to welcome them as soon as it's safe to travel.





These transports take a village — from our rescue partners and flight crews to every donor, volunteer, and adopter who believes every animal deserves a chance.

A KITTEN SEASON LIKE NO OTHER: HELP US CARE FOR THE LITTLEST LIVES

Every year, shelters across the country brace themselves for "kitten season" — the time when unspayed community cats give birth faster than rescues can keep up. But this year, Pets Alive has seen one of the busiest kitten seasons in our history.

Since spring, our team has taken in a surging number of tiny kittens in need — many orphaned, sick, or too young to survive on their own. Some

arrived barely a day old, requiring round-the-clock bottle feeding. Others came to us malnourished, battling upper respiratory infections or parasites that could be deadly without immediate care.

NEW NYS SHELTER REGULATIONS ARE COMING — AND PETS ALIVE IS READY TO MEET THE CHALLENGE

New York State has announced comprehensive new companion animal shelter regulations that will take effect on **December 15**, **2025** — the first major update to our state's shelter standards in nearly two decades. These important changes are designed to improve the quality of care and ensure safe, healthy environments for animals waiting for their forever homes.



At Pets Alive, we welcome these upgrades with open arms... and wagging tails! From enhanced housing requirements to improved ventilation, sanitation, enrichment, and medical care standards — every component supports the welfare of the dogs and cats who rely on us.
